Our Timeline...

- 1967** → R.W. Roman starts applying for meadery license in Ontario.
- 1974** → R.W. Roman stop after 6 years of trying to obtain a meadery license.
- 1982** → Eugene & Renata Roman honeymoon in Niagara-on-the-Lake and fall in love with the region. Eugene promises that one day they'll build a winery & meadery together.
- 1999** → 40-acres on the Beamsville Bench is purchased for the future of Rosewood.
- 2003** → First vines are planted. Renaceau Vineyard is born.
- 2005** → Rosewood winery building is built.
- 2006** → First wine harvest
- 2007** → Jordan vineyard property is purchased for future 'Blackjack Vineyard'
- 2008** → Rosewood opens its doors to the public, releasing the inaugural 2006 vintage.
- 2009** → Blackjack Vineyard (Jordan property) is planted.
- 2014** → In March record low temperatures killed 1/3 of the vines across both vineyards.
- 2015** → Replacement blocks are planted - new varietals: Pinot Gris, Gamay Noir and Petit Verdot.
- 2016** → Rosewood celebrates 10-years of winemaking on the Bench.
- 2018** → Rosewood begins construction of a new expansion at the winery and celebrates 10-years of being open and the team is excited to see what the next decade holds. Cheers to the journey.
